## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to limit the highest ordinary rate that a council may make for rateable land in both a residential sub-category and a contiguous urban area.

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Local Government (General) Amendment (Rates) Regulation 2021*.

#### **Clause 124**

Insert after clause 123—

#### **124 Highest ordinary rate for certain rateable land**

For the purposes of the Act, section 530(4), the factor of 1.5 times is prescribed.
