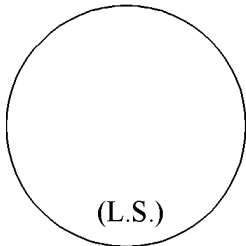

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to amend the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*, Schedule 14 by altering the name of the lands reserved as Mount Yarrowyck Nature Reserve to Bulagaranda (Mt Yarrowyck) Aboriginal Area.
