Final Determination

under the

Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

The Scientific Committee established under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* has made a final determination under Part 4, Division 3 of the Act to list a species as a critically endangered species and, as a consequence, omit a reference to the species as an endangered species.

Accordingly, Schedule 1 of the Act is amended by—

- (a) inserting in alphabetical order in the matter relating to Rutaceae in Part 1, Division 2—

Asterolasia beckersii Orme & Duretto (as described in the notice of, and reasons for, the Final Determination of the Scientific Committee to list the species)

- (b) omitting from the matter relating to Rutaceae in Part 2, Division 3—

Asterolasia beckersii Orme & Duretto

This final determination commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.
