1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts—Amendment No 4) Order 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Allocation of the administration of Act

- (1) The administration of the Act listed in Schedule 1 is allocated to the Ministers indicated in that Schedule.
- (2) The allocation made by this Order replaces any previous allocation relating to the Act concerned that is inconsistent with the allocation made by this Order.
