Explanatory note

The Net Zero Emissions and Clean Economy Board established in accordance with the *Energy and Utilities Administration Act 1987* is required to consider the State's emissions reduction objectives in exercising its functions.

The object of this Regulation is to update a reference to the State's 2030 emissions reduction objective from a reduction of at least 35% of 2005 emissions levels to a reduction of at least 50% of 2005 emissions levels.
