Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Surveillance Devices Regulation 2014* to extend, by 2 years, the trial period during which ambulance officers may use body-worn recording devices, which is otherwise due to expire on 30 November 2021.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Surveillance Devices Amendment (Body-Worn Recording Devices) Regulation 2021*.
