Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the period for making disclosures of political donations made during the half-year ending on 31 December 2021 from 4 weeks to 8 weeks after the end of the half-year.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Electoral Funding Amendment (Political Donations Disclosure Period) Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Electoral Funding Regulation 2018

Clause 48

Insert after clause 47—

48 Political donations disclosures for July–December 2021 period

For the purposes of the Act, section 15(1)(b), for political donations received or made during the half year ending on 31 December 2021, the period of 8 weeks after the end of the half-year is prescribed.
