The objects of this Regulation are as follows—

- (a) to enable certain hotels and clubs to trade during extended hours for certain special events,
- (b) to prescribe a fee for applications under the *Liquor Act 2007*, section 94B.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Liquor Amendment (Special Events Extended Trading) Regulation 2021.

2 Commencement

- (1) Subject to subclause (2), this Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.
- (2) Schedule 1[1] commences on the later of the following—
 - (a) the date of assent to the Customer Service Legislation Amendment Act 2021,
 - (b) the day on which this Regulation is published on the NSW legislation website.
