Gas Supply and Pipelines Amendment Regulation 2021

- (a) *Gas Supply Act 1996*,
- (b) *Pipelines Act 1967*.

Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are as follows—

- (a) to include a definition of natural gas in the *Gas Supply (Safety and Network Management) Regulation 2013*,
- (b) consequential on the commencement of the *Energy Legislation Amendment Act 2021*, to make amendments to the *Gas Supply (Natural Gas Retail) Regulation 2014* and the *Pipelines Regulation 2013*.

Gas Supply and Pipelines Amendment Regulation 2021

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Gas Supply and Pipelines Amendment Regulation 2021*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Gas Supply (Natural Gas Retail) Regulation 2014

[1] Clause 3, heading

Omit “**Definitions**” Insert instead “**Definition**”.

[2] Clause 3(1)

Omit the definition of *gas*.

Schedule 2 Amendment of Gas Supply (Safety and Network Management) Regulation 2013

Clause 3 Definitions

Insert in alphabetical order in clause 3(1)—

natural gas means a substance that—

- (a) is in a gaseous state at standard temperature and pressure, and
- (b) consists of hydrocarbons, or a mixture of hydrocarbons and non-hydrocarbons, the principal constituent of which is methane, and
- (c) has been processed or otherwise dealt with to make it suitable for consumption.

Schedule 3 Amendment of Pipelines Regulation 2013

Clause 36 Maximum annual licence fee per kilometre of pipeline

Omit the clause.
