# Personal Injury Commission Amendment (Independent Review Officer Remuneration) Regulation 2021

under the

Personal Injury Commission Act 2020

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide for the remuneration of the Independent Review Officer (the **IRO**) under the *Personal Injury Commission Act 2020* pending the determination of the IRO's remuneration under the *Statutory and Other Officers Remuneration Act 1975*. The IRO's remuneration must be the same as that of the Workers Compensation Independent Review Officer (the **WIRO**) under the *Workplace Injury Management and Workers Compensation Act 1998* immediately before the WIRO was taken to have been appointed as the IRO under the *Personal Injury Commission Act 2020*.

This Regulation is made under the *Personal Injury Commission Act 2020*, including Schedule 1, clause 1.

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### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Personal Injury Commission Amendment (Independent Review Officer Remuneration) Regulation 2021*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Amendment of Personal Injury Commission Act 2020 No 18**

#### **Schedule 1 Savings, transitional and other provisions**

Insert after clause 16—

#### **17A Independent Review Officer—remuneration**

The Independent Review Officer is, until the earlier of the following, entitled to the same remuneration the current WIRO was entitled to immediately before the establishment day—

- (a) the day on which a determination of the Independent Review Officer's remuneration comes into force under the *Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act 1975*,
- (b) the day that is 6 months after the day on which this clause commences.
