## **Administrative Arrangements (Second Perrottet Ministry— Allocation of Acts and Agencies) Order 2021**

under the

Constitution Act 1902

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Second Perrottet Ministry—Allocation of Acts and Agencies) Order 2021*.

### **2 Commencement**

- (1) Except as provided by subclause (2), this Order commences on 21 December 2021 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
- (2) Clause 3(3) and (4) and Schedule 2 commence on 1 April 2022.

### **3 Repeals**

- (1) The following cease to have effect—
  - (a) an order that only allocates the administration of Acts,
  - (b) a provision of another order allocates the administration of Acts.
- (2) To avoid doubt, the allocations made by this Order, Schedule 1 replace any previous allocations relating to the Acts concerned that are inconsistent with the allocations made by the Schedule.
- (3) A provision of another order that specifies the Minister to whom a Public Service agency is responsible ceases to have effect.
- (4) To avoid doubt, the specifications made by this Order, Schedule 2 replace any previous specifications that are inconsistent with the specification made by the Schedule.

## Schedule 1 Allocation of the administration of Acts

### Allocation of Acts

- (1) The administration of an Act listed in this Schedule is allocated to the Minister indicated in the Schedule.
- (2) The administration of an Act or parts of an Act that directly amends another Act is allocated to the Minister administering the Act amended.

**Note—** See the *Interpretation Act 1987*, section 15 for the interpretation of references to “the Minister” in an Act.
