1 Name of Order

This Order is the Administrative Arrangements (Administrative Changes—Ministers and Public Service Agencies) Order (No 5) 2021.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Administrative Arrangements (Second Perrottet Ministry—Allocation of Acts and Agencies) Order 2021

(1) Schedule 2 Ministers to whom Public Service agencies responsible

Omit "Minister for Lands and Water" from the matter relating to the Department of Regional NSW in clause 1.

(2) Schedule 2, clause 1

Insert "Minister for Regional Youth" after the Minister for Western New South Wales in the matter relating to the Department of Regional NSW.

(3) Schedule 2, clause 1

Omit "Minister for Regional Youth" from the matter relating to the Department of Communities and Justice.

4 Amendment of Administrative Arrangements (Second Perrottet Ministry— Transitional) Order 2021

Schedule 4 Amendment of Government Sector Employment Act 2013 No 40

Omit "Department of Premier and Cabinet" wherever occurring in Schedule 4[2], Part 2, other than in the matter relating to the Parliamentary Counsel's Office.

Insert instead "Department of Enterprise, Investment and Trade".
