Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to update the prescribed forms for application notices to broaden the standard apprehended violence orders about behaviour to include harming particular animals.

This Regulation is made under the *Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Act 2007*, including sections 50(2) and 101 (the general regulation-making power).
