

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Act 2007 to—

- (a) extend the definition of *intimidation* to include harm to an animal in certain circumstances, and
- (b) clarify that the prohibition relating to destroying or damaging property of a protected person, which is taken to be specified in every apprehended violence order, extends to harming an animal, and
- (c) require an apprehended domestic violence order, which must be imposed by the court against certain persons sentenced to imprisonment, to continue for a period of 2 years after the person's term of imprisonment ends or for another period specified by the court.
