# Motor Accident Injuries (Indexation) Amendment Order 2022

## Explanatory note

This Order notifies the number that equates to the factor  $\frac{B}{C}$  used in the formula set out in the *Motor Accident Injuries Act 2017 (the Act)*, section 3.22.

The number is used to calculate the variation of the amount of a weekly payment of statutory benefits to be paid to a person who has been injured in a motor accident to which the Act applies.

The Act, section 3.22 requires the amount of a weekly payment of statutory benefits to be varied on 1 April and 1 October each year.

### 1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Motor Accident Injuries (Indexation) Amendment Order 2022*.

### 2 Commencement

This Order commences on 1 April 2022 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

### 3 Amendment of Motor Accident Injuries (Indexation) Order 2017

#### Clause 4A Section 3.22: Indexation of weekly statutory benefits

Insert at the end of the Table —

1 April 2022	0.999
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**Note—** Under the Act, section 3.22(5)(a), the variation for 1 April 2022 is deemed not to have taken effect. Accordingly, the amount of a weekly payment of statutory benefits will not be varied from 1 April 2022. However, under the Act, section 3.22(5)(b), this variation will be offset against the next variation that results in an increase in the amount of a weekly payment of statutory benefits.
