1 Name of Order

Omit clause 7. Insert instead—

7 Transfer of certain DPC staff to DEIT

(1) The persons employed in Create NSW and Create Infrastructure in the Department of Premier and Cabinet are transferred to the Department of Enterprise, Investment and Trade.

(2) A reference in a document to the Department of Premier and Cabinet is, if used in relation to the part of the Department referred to in subclause (1), to be read as a reference to the Department of Enterprise, Investment and Trade.
