Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include Transdev John Holland Buses (NSW) Pty Ltd (*Transdev*) in the list of employers in the *Superannuation Act 1916*, Schedule 3.

As a result, a person may continue to be a contributor to the State Superannuation Fund for the purposes of the Act if—

- (a) the person was a contributor to the Fund immediately before 3 April 2022 and the person's employment was transferred to Transdev in accordance with the Transitional Agreement dated 18 November 2021, or
- (b) the person—
 - (i) was, immediately before commencing employment with Transdev—
 - (A) an employee in the State Transit Authority Group of the Transport Service of New South Wales, and
 - (B) a contributor to the Fund, and
 - (ii) received a written undertaking from Transdev that Transdev would continue contributing to the Fund on behalf of the person.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Superannuation Amendment (Transdev John Holland Buses (NSW) Pty Ltd) Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

Schedule 3 List of employers

Insert at the end of Part 1—

Transdev John Holland Buses (NSW) Pty Ltd (*Transdev*), limited to—

- (a) persons—
 - (i) whose employment was transferred on 3 April 2022, having received and accepted an offer of employment under the Transitional Agreement dated 18 November 2021 between the Secretary of the Department of Transport, on behalf of the State, and Transdev, and
 - (ii) who, immediately before 3 April 2022, were contributors to the Fund, or
- (b) persons who—
 - (i) immediately before commencing employment with Transdev were—
 - (A) employees in the State Transit Authority Group of the Transport Service of New South Wales, and
 - (B) contributors to the Fund, and
 - (ii) received a written undertaking from Transdev that Transdev would continue contributing to the Fund on behalf of the person.
