Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

The Scientific Committee established under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* has made a determination under the Act, Part 4, Division 4 to list a species as a critically endangered species on an emergency basis.

Accordingly, the Act, Schedule 1 is amended by inserting in alphabetical order in the matter relating to Agamidae in Part 1, Division 1—

Tympanocryptis lineata Peters, 1863

Canberra Grassland Earless Dragon
