Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide that a licence or other authorisation issued under the *Work Health* and Safety Regulation 2017 in digital form is not required to contain a signature.

This Regulation is made under the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*, including section 276, the general regulation-making power, and Schedule 3, clause 7.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Work Health and Safety Amendment (Licences in Digital Form) Regulation 2022.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Work Health and Safety Regulation 2017

Clause 702D

Insert after clause 702C—

702D Signature not required for licences in digital form

- (1) A provision in this Regulation requiring a licence to contain a signature does not apply to the digital form of the licence.
- (2) In this clause—

licence has the same meaning as in the *Licensing and Registration* (*Uniform Procedures*) Act 2002, Part 4B.
