Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Design and Building Practitioners Act 2020* (*the Act*)—

- (a) to consolidate the concepts of 'equivalent authorisation' and 'relevant authorisation', as used in the Act, by inserting a single definition of **relevant authorisation** to refer to certain qualifications and authorisations related to practitioners under the Act, and
- (b) to provide that, if a practitioner under the Act is a registered body corporate, the Secretary of the Department of Customer Service may take disciplinary action under the Act, Part 6 against a director of the body corporate.
