Water Management (Application of Act to Central Coast Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Water Source) Proclamation 2022

1 Name of Proclamation

This Proclamation is the Water Management (Application of Act to Central Coast Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Water Source) Proclamation 2022.

2 Commencement

This Proclamation commences on the day on which it is published in the Gazette.

3 Application of Water Management Act 2000, Chapter 3, Parts 2 and 3 to the Central Coast Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Water Source, access licences and approvals

- (1) It is declared that the following apply to the Central Coast Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Water Source to which the prescribed water sharing plan applies, to the extent they did not apply immediately before the commencement of this proclamation:
 - (a) The Act, Chapter 3, Part 2 in relation to all categories and subcategories of access licences for the water source, other than floodplain harvesting access licences,
 - (b) The Act, Chapter 3, Part 3 in relation to all approvals for the water source, other than drainage work approvals, flood work approvals and aquifer interferences approvals.

(2) In this clause:

prescribed water sharing plan means the Water Sharing Plan for the Central Coast Unregulated and Alluvial Water Sources 2022.

the Act means the Water Management Act 2000.
