Order regarding volunteers taking part in emergency operations

under the

State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989

I, Dominic Perrottet MP, Premier of the State of New South Wales, by this Order under the *State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989*, section 60D, direct that the provisions of that Act, Part 3A apply to emergency operations carried out by the following persons in connection with the emergency caused by floods and storms in the State—

- (a) all volunteer emergency workers from the State Emergency Service,
- (b) all volunteer rural fire fighters within the meaning of the *Rural Fires Act 1997*,
- (c) all volunteer emergency workers from Surf Life Saving New South Wales,
- (d) all volunteer emergency workers from Volunteer Marine Rescue NSW,
- (e) all volunteer emergency workers from New South Wales Volunteer Rescue Association Inc.

The Order made by the Commissioner of the State Emergency Service under the *State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989*, section 60D on 6 July 2022 is revoked.

This Order remains in force for 21 days from the date of its publication on the NSW legislation website, unless sooner revoked.
