Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the operation of the *Water Industry Competition (General) Regulation 2021* until 1 September 2023. The Regulation is currently under review as significant changes will be made to the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006* following the commencement of the *Water Industry Competition Amendment Act 2021*.

This Regulation also makes a minor amendment to correct a reference to an Australian Standard.

This Regulation is made under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006*, including sections 13(1)(a) and 101, the general regulation-making power.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Water Industry Competition (General) Amendment Regulation 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Water Industry Competition (General) Regulation 2021

(1) Section 57 Repeal

Omit “This regulation is repealed on 1 September 2022”.

Insert instead “This Regulation is repealed on 1 September 2023”.

(2) Schedule 2 Conditions for retail suppliers’ licences

Omit the definition of *AS/ISO 10002—2006* from section 4(3).

Insert instead—

AS/ISO 10002—2006 means the Australian Standard entitled AS ISO 10002—2006, *Customer Satisfaction—Guidelines for complaints handling in organizations*, as published by Standards Australia in April 2006.
