

I, the Honourable Chief Justice Andrew Scott Bell, Administrator of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2(a) of the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Amendment Act 2022*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 September 2022 as the day on which that Act, Schedule 1[9] and [10], to the extent it inserts section 36D of the *Child Protection (Working With Children) Act 2012*, commence.

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions amending the Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012 which—

- (a) authorise the Children's Guardian to exchange information with a body in another State or Territory that conducts child-related work screening, and
- (b) require the Children's Guardian to record on the National Reference System database information about a person—
 - (i) barred from holding a working with children check clearance, or
 - (ii) disqualified from holding a working with children check clearance, or
 - (iii) refused a working with children check clearance, or
 - (iv) whose working with children check clearance is cancelled.
