### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Rail Safety (Adoption of National Law) Amendment Regulation 2022*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on 1 September 2022.

### **3 Amendment of Rail Safety (Adoption of National Law) Regulation 2018**

#### **(1) Clause 3 Definitions**

Omit “AS 3547—1997, *Breath alcohol testing devices for personal use*” from clause 3(1), definition of *preliminary breath test*.

Insert instead “AS 3547:2019, *Breath alcohol testing devices*, as reissued in January 2021”.

#### **(2) Clause 17 Taking and dealing with oral fluid samples**

Omit “section 2 of AS 4760—2006” from clause 17(2)(a).

Insert instead “AS/NZS 4760:2019, section 2”.

#### **(3) Clause 17(4)(c)**

Omit “section 2 of AS 4760—2006”. Insert instead “AS/NZS 4760:2019, section 2”.

#### **(4) Clause 17(7)**

Omit the definition of *AS 4760—2006*. Insert instead—

*AS/NZS 4760:2019* means Australian/New Zealand Standard 4760:2019, *Procedure for specimen collection and the detection and quantification of drugs in oral fluid*, as reissued in September 2020.
