#### 1 Name of Order

This Order is the Environmental Planning and Assessment Amendment (Waratah Super Battery Project—Munmorah) Order 2022.

#### 2 Commencement

### 3 Amendment of State Environmental Planning Policy (Planning Systems) 2021 Schedule 5 Critical State significant infrastructure

Insert at the end of the Schedule, with appropriate section numbering—

#### Waratah Super Battery Project—Munmorah

- (1) Development for the purposes of the Waratah Super Battery Project—Munmorah, including the following—
  - (a) the installation and operation of a battery,
  - (b) the construction and operation of transmission lines and related electricity infrastructure to connect the battery to the Munmorah Substation,
  - (c) the construction and operation of a System Integrity Protection Scheme, which is a communications and control system that enables the battery to supply electricity when required,
  - (d) ancillary development.
- (2) The development is to be carried out on the site of the former Munmorah Power Station at Colongra.
- (3) The development does not include surveys, sampling, environmental investigations, archaeological excavations or other tests for the assessment of the Waratah Super Battery Project—Munmorah.
