Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make amendments to the *Teacher Accreditation Regulation 2015* consequent on amendments made by the *Teacher Accreditation Amendment Act 2021*.

This Regulation is made under the *Teacher Accreditation Act 2004*, including section 52, the general regulation-making power.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Teacher Accreditation Amendment Regulation 2022.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Teacher Accreditation Regulation 2015

(1) Clause 3 Definitions

Omit clause 3(1), definitions of elected member, election of a representative of early childhood education centre teachers, election of a representative of government school teachers and principals, election of a representative of non-government school teachers and principals and electoral list.

(2) Parts 3 and 4

Omit the Parts.

(3) Clauses 66, 67, 67A and 68 and Schedules 1 and 2

Omit the provisions.
