## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to make amendments to the *Teacher Accreditation Regulation 2015* consequent on amendments made by the *Teacher Accreditation Amendment Act 2021*.

This Regulation is made under the *Teacher Accreditation Act 2004*, including section 52, the general regulation-making power.

### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Teacher Accreditation Amendment Regulation 2022*.

### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### 3 Amendment of Teacher Accreditation Regulation 2015

#### (1) Clause 3 Definitions

Omit clause 3(1), definitions of *elected member*, *election of a representative of early childhood education centre teachers*, *election of a representative of government school teachers and principals*, *election of a representative of non-government school teachers and principals* and *electoral list*.

#### (2) Parts 3 and 4

Omit the Parts.

#### (3) Clauses 66, 67, 67A and 68 and Schedules 1 and 2

Omit the provisions.
