Mining and Petroleum Legislation Amendment Act 2022 No 21

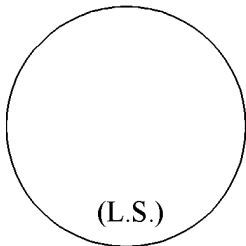

I, the Honourable Margaret Beazley AC KC, Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Mining and Petroleum Legislation Amendment Act 2022*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 21 October 2022 as the day on which the following provisions of the Act commence—

- (a) Schedule 1[1], [3]–[6], [14], [16], [17], [21], [22], [24], [29], [30], [32]–[34], [41], [47], [50], [63], [67], [72], [76], [78], [81]–[94], [106], [107], [121], [123], to the extent it inserts sections 292W and 292X, [124]–[126], [128]–[133], [135], [136], [138], [141]–[143], [145]–[151], [155], [157], [160], [161], [163]–[165], [174], [176], [177], [178], to the extent that it inserts Schedule 6, Part 27, clauses 181, 182 and 186, [179]–[181], [182], to the extent that it inserts the definitions of **Planning Secretary**, **Royalties for Rejuvenation Fund** or **Rejuvenation Fund** and **state conservation area**, [183] and [185],
- (b) Schedule 2[7], [14], [25] and [91], to the extent that it inserts Schedule 1, Part 15, clauses 67 and 72.
