# Companion Animals Amendment Regulation 2022

under the

Companion Animals Act 1998

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to enable, consequent on the commencement of the *Public Spaces (Unattended Property) Act 2021*, the following persons to access the Register of Companion Animals as established by the *Companion Animals Act 1998*—

- (a) the Secretary of the Department of Planning and Environment, or a person authorised by the Secretary, to the extent required for the purposes of the administration or execution of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*,
- (b) an authorised officer within the meaning of the *Public Spaces (Unattended Property) Act 2021*, to the extent required for the purposes of exercising a function under that Act.

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Companion Animals Amendment Regulation 2022*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on 1 November 2022.

### **3 Amendment of Companion Animals Regulation 2018**

#### **Clause 30 Additional persons who may access Register**

Omit clause 30(e) and (f). Insert instead—

- (e) the Secretary of the Department of Planning and Environment, or a person authorised by the Secretary, but only to the extent required for the purposes of the administration or execution of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974*,
- (f) an authorised officer within the meaning of the *Public Spaces (Unattended Property) Act 2021*, but only to the extent required for the purposes of exercising a function under that Act,
