Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend the period during which regulations may be made under the *Constitution Act 1902* (*the Act*) about the ways and forms in which meetings of the Executive Council are to be held, including the ways and forms in which the Governor may preside at meetings. The object is achieved by amending the *Constitution (Executive Council Processes) Regulation 2020* to prescribe 26 September 2023 as the end of the period during which regulations may be made under the Act, Schedule 8.

1 Name of Regulation
