#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Amendment* (Digital Certificates) Regulation 2022.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### 3 Amendment of Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Regulation 2017

#### Clause 16A

Insert before clause 17—

#### 16A Execution of documents—the Act, s 10(1)

- (1) For a digital certificate, a facsimile of the Registrar's signature and seal is authorised to be produced in digital form.
- (2) In this clause—

digital certificate means an electronic certificate—

- (a) issued by the Registrar under the Act, and
- (b) displayed on a mobile phone or other electronic device.

digital form includes a digitised, electronic or computer generated image.
