# **Biodiversity Conservation Amendment (Bushfire-Affected Development) Regulation 2022**

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to provide that certain bushfire-affected development involving the clearing of native vegetation is not taken to exceed the biodiversity offsets scheme threshold until 27 November 2023.

This Regulation is made under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*, including section 7.4(1).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Biodiversity Conservation Amendment (Bushfire-Affected Development) Regulation 2022*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Amendment of Biodiversity Conservation Regulation 2017**

(1) **Clause 7.1A Certain bushfire-affected development involving clearing taken not to exceed threshold**

Omit “2 years after the commencement of this clause” from clause 7.1A(1)(b).

Insert instead “27 November 2023”.

(2) **Clause 7.1A(2)**

Omit the subclause.
