Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide that certain bushfire-affected development involving the clearing of native vegetation is not taken to exceed the biodiversity offsets scheme threshold until 27 November 2023.

This Regulation is made under the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016, including section 7.4(1).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Biodiversity Conservation Amendment (Bushfire-Affected Development) Regulation 2022.*

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Biodiversity Conservation Regulation 2017

(1) Clause 7.1A Certain bushfire-affected development involving clearing taken not to exceed threshold

Omit "2 years after the commencement of this clause" from clause 7.1A(1)(b). Insert instead "27 November 2023".

(2) Clause 7.1A(2)

Omit the subclause.
