Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence Schedule 1[1] of the Crimes Legislation Amendment (Coercive Control) Act 2022, to the extent it inserts section 54I, on 1 December 2022. The provision requires the Attorney General to establish a Coercive Control Implementation and Evaluation Taskforce.
