

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Amendment Act 2022*, other than amendments to the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016* that—

- (a) remove limits on the provision of taxi services to specified areas of operation, and
- (b) cancel all remaining existing licences to provide taxi services.
