### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to specify the meaning of a well-head of petroleum.

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Petroleum (Onshore) Act 1991

#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Petroleum (Onshore) Amendment Regulation 2022.

#### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 March 2023.

#### 3 Amendment of Petroleum (Onshore) Regulation 2016

#### Clause 51A

Insert after clause 51—

#### 51A Meaning of "well-head"—the Act, s 3(1), definition of "well-head"

A well-head, of petroleum-

- (a) means the equipment installed at the surface of a well to contain pressure and provide an interface for drilling and production equipment, and
- (b) includes the following—
  - (i) the casing head,
  - (ii) a casing hanger or spool,
  - (iii) a tubing hanger,
  - (iv) flow equipment, up to and including the wing valves.
