

Liquor Amendment (Miscellaneous) Regulation 2022

under the

Liquor Act 2007

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Liquor Act 2007*.

Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are to—

- (a) enable individuals who have completed an approved interstate Responsible Service of Alcohol (*RSA*) training course to work in New South Wales for the period starting on the day the Regulation is notified and ending at the end of 31 January 2023, and
- (b) enable individuals whose principal place of residence is in a State or Territory other than New South Wales and who have completed an approved interstate RSA training course to work in New South Wales from 1 February 2023, and
- (c) require individuals whose principal place of residence is in a State or Territory other than New South Wales and who have completed an approved interstate RSA training course to provide evidence to police officers or inspectors on request, and
- (d) extend the term of approved training providers to 5 years, and
- (e) provide extended trading for hotels and clubs for special events in 2023, and
- (f) make minor amendments consequential on the Gaming Machines Amendment (Responsible Conduct of Gaming Training) Regulation 2022.

This Regulation is made under the *Liquor Act 2007*, including sections 13, 114F(2) and 159, the general regulation-making power.

Liquor Amendment (Miscellaneous) Regulation 2022

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Liquor Amendment (Miscellaneous) Regulation 2022.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences as follows—

- (a) for Schedule 1[1], to the extent it inserts clause 63(4A)(a), [2] and [3]—1 February 2023,
- (b) otherwise—the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Liquor Regulation 2018

[1] Clause 63 Requirements to sell, supply or serve liquor by retail on licensed premises

Insert after the heading "Exemptions"—

- (4A) Subclauses (1) and (2) do not apply in relation to a staff member—
 - (a) whose principal place of residence is a State or Territory other than New South Wales, and
 - (b) who has completed an approved interstate RSA training course within the previous 5 years.

[2] Clause 63(8)

Insert after clause 63(7)—

(8) In this clause—

principal place of residence means the place of residence or home that a person primarily occupies, on an ongoing and permanent basis, as the person's settled or usual home.

[3] Clause 72 Issue of recognised competency card with endorsements

Omit clause 72(1)(e). Insert instead—

- (e) that the person has completed one of the following (an *RCG* endorsement)—
 - (i) an RCG training course within the previous 5 years,
 - (ii) an RCG training course earlier than within the previous 5 years and an RCG refresher course within the previous 5 years,
 - (iii) an advanced RCG training course within the previous 5 years.

[4] Clause 75 Inspection of recognised competency card

Insert after clause 75(1)—

(1A) A police officer or inspector may require any person who is exempt from a requirement to hold a recognised competency card under clause 63(4A) to produce evidence of the person's exemption from the requirement to the police officer or inspector for inspection.

[5] Clause 75(2)

Insert "or (1A)" after "subclause (1)".

[6] Clause 81 Term of approval to provide training courses

Omit "until 30 June following" from clause 81(1). Insert instead "for a period of five years from".

[7] Schedule 5 Special events extended trading for hotels and clubs

Omit the table to the Schedule. Insert instead—
