

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the Fisheries Management Act 1994 that—

- (a) replace the licensing scheme for charter fishing boats with a scheme that licences charter fishing activities, and
- (b) make provision for the transfer of charter fishing licences and associated entitlements, and
- (c) make other miscellaneous and consequential amendments.
