Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are to—

- (a) provide that councils are not required to publish amounts that appear to be tendered in tender submissions on the council's website, and
- (b) enable councils to omit that information from the council's website if published before the commencement of this Regulation.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Local Government (General) Amendment (Tendering) Regulation 2023*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Local Government (General) Regulation 2021

(1) Section 175 Formal receipt and opening of tender submissions

Omit section 175(5). Insert instead—

- (5) The council must, as soon as practicable after the information recorded is verified, publish the names of the tenderers on the council's website.

(2) Part 14, heading

Omit “and repeal”. Insert instead “, repeal and transitional provisions”.

(3) Section 416

Insert after section 415—

416 Tender information published under section 175

A council may omit from the council's website information published in accordance with section 175(5)(b) as in force immediately before the commencement of the *Local Government (General) Amendment (Tendering) Regulation 2023*.
