# Electoral Funding (Adjustable Amounts) (Electoral Expenditure) Notice 2023

under the

Electoral Funding Act 2018

## 1 Name of Notice

This Notice is the *Electoral Funding (Adjustable Amounts) (Electoral Expenditure) Notice 2023*.

## 2 Definition

In this Notice—

*the Act* means the *Electoral Funding Act 2018*.

## 3 Adjustment for inflation

For the purposes of clause 3(1) of Schedule 1 to the Act, the adjustable amounts that are to apply for a subsequent election period set out in Schedule 1 are the amounts specified in the Schedule.

## Schedule 1 Electoral expenditure caps

### 1 Adjustment--applicable caps on electoral expenditure for State election campaigns: section 29 of the Act

#### (1) Parties with Assembly candidates in a general election: section 29(2) of the Act

<u>First day of election period</u>	<u>Adjustable amount</u>
26 March 2023	\$150,700
24 March 2019	\$132,600

#### (2) Other parties with Council candidates in a general election: section 29(4) of the Act

<u>First day of election period</u>	<u>Adjustable amount</u>

24 March 2019	\$1,389,900

#### (3) Independent groups of candidates in Council general elections: section 29(5) of the Act

#### (4) Party candidates in Assembly general election: section 29(6) of the Act

#### (5) Independent candidates in Assembly general election: section 29(7) of the Act

#### (6) Non-grouped candidates in Council general election: section 29(8) of the Act

<u>First day of election period</u>	<u>Adjustable amount</u>

(7) **Candidates in Assembly by-election: section 29(9) of the Act**

<u>First day of election period</u>	<u>Adjustable amount</u>
26 March 2023	\$301,200
24 March 2019	\$265,000

(8) **Third-party campaigners at a general election: section 29(10)(a) and (b) of the Act**

<u>First day of election period</u>	<u>Adjustable amount</u>
26 March 2023	(a) \$1,464,200 if the third-party campaigner was registered before the commencement of the capped State expenditure period for the election,  or  (b) \$732,200 in other cases
24 March 2019	(a) \$1,288,500 if the third-party campaigner was registered before the commencement of the capped State expenditure period for the election,  or  (b) \$644,300 in other cases

(9) **Additional cap for individual Assembly seats: section 29(12)(a) and (b) of the Act**

<u>First day of election period</u>	<u>Adjustable amount</u>
26 March 2023	(a) \$75,500 in the case of a party,  or  (b) \$30,400 in the case of a third-party campaigner
24 March 2019	(a) \$66,400 in the case of a party,  or  (b) \$26,700 in the case of a third-party campaigner

(10) **Maximum campaign office expenditure not included in electoral expenditure cap: section 7(4B) of the Act**
