Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include Life Without Barriers in the list of employers in the Superannuation Act 1916, Schedule 3.

As a result, those persons who, immediately before commencing employment with Life Without Barriers, were employees of Australian Unity Home Care Service Pty Ltd and were contributors to the State Superannuation Fund may continue to be contributors to the Fund for the purposes of the Act.

This Order is made under the Superannuation Act 1916, section 92(1)(a), a Henry VIII provision.
