## Final Determination

under the

### Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

The Scientific Committee established under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* has made a final determination under the Act, Part 4, Division 3 to list a species as a vulnerable species and, as a consequence, omit a reference to the species as an endangered species.

Accordingly, the Act, Schedule 1 is amended as follows—

- (a) Part 2, Division 4 is amended by omitting from the matter relating to Cacatuidae—
