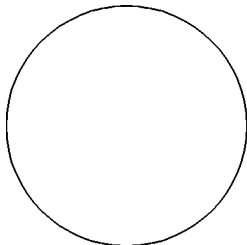

Water Management (Application of Act to Towamba River Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source) Proclamation 2023

1 Name of Proclamation

This Proclamation is the *Water Management (Application of Act to Towamba River Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source) Proclamation 2023*.

2 Commencement

This Proclamation commences on 1 July 2023.

3 Application of Parts 2 and 3 of Chapter 3 of the Water Management Act 2000 to the Towamba River Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source, access licences and approvals

- (1) It is declared that Part 2 of Chapter 3 of the Act applies to the Towamba River Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source to which the prescribed water sharing plan applies in relation to all categories and subcategories of access licences for that water source other than floodplain harvesting (regulated river) access licences and floodplain harvesting (unregulated river) access licences.
- (2) It is declared that Part 3 of Chapter 3 of the Act applies to the Towamba River Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source to which the prescribed water sharing plan applies in relation to all approvals for that water source other than drainage work approvals and aquifer interference approvals.
- (3) In this clause:

prescribed water sharing plan means the *Water Sharing Plan for the Towamba River Unregulated and Alluvial Water Sources 2023*.

the Act means the *Water Management Act 2000*.
