

Water Management (Application of Act to Tweed River Area Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source) Proclamation 2023

1 Name of Proclamation

This Proclamation is the Water Management (Application of Act to Tweed River Area Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source) Proclamation 2023.

2 Commencement

This Proclamation commences on 1 July 2023 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

- 3 Application of Parts 2 and 3 of Chapter 3 of the Water Management Act 2000 to the Tweed River Area Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source, access licences and approvals
 - (1) It is declared that Part 2 of Chapter 3 of the Act applies to the Tweed River Area Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source to which the prescribed water sharing plan applies in relation to all categories and subcategories of access licences for those groundwater sources other than floodplain harvesting (regulated river) access licences and floodplain harvesting (unregulated river) access licences.
 - (2) It is declared that Part 3 of Chapter 3 of the Act applies to the Tweed River Area Coastal Floodplain Alluvial Groundwater Source to which the prescribed water sharing plan applies in relation to all approvals for those groundwater sources other than drainage work approvals and aquifer interference approvals.
 - (3) In this clause:

prescribed water sharing plan means the Water Sharing Plan for the Tweed River Area Unregulated and Alluvial Water Sources 2023.

the Act means the Water Management Act 2000.
