Work Health and Safety Amendment (Demolition Licensing) Regulation 2023

under the

Work Health and Safety Act 2011

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Work Health and Safety Amendment (Demolition Licensing) Regulation 2022* to provide that on commencement of that Regulation—

- (a) the holder of a restricted demolition licence can apply to be authorised to undertake 1 or more activities (a **restricted demolition activity**) ordinarily undertaken by the holder of an unrestricted demolition licence, and
- (b) the Regulator can amend a restricted demolition licence to vary or delete an authorisation given to the licence holder to carry out a restricted demolition activity.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Work Health and Safety Amendment (Demolition Licensing) Regulation 2023*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Work Health and Safety Amendment (Demolition Licensing) Regulation 2022

(1) Schedule 1 Amendment of Work Health and Safety Regulation 2017

Insert at the end of Schedule 1[3], proposed clause 143M(1)(b)—

, or

(c) vary or delete an authorisation given under clause 143N(1)(b).

(2) Schedule 1[3], proposed clause 143N(1)

Omit the subclause. Insert instead—

(1) The regulator may, on application by the licence holder in a form approved by the regulator, amend a demolition licence, including to—

- (a) vary or delete a condition of the licence, or
- (b) authorise the licence holder to undertake 1 or more of the following types of demolition work—
 - (i) demolition work on a structure over 15 metres in height,
 - (ii) demolition work on a structure that is a chemical installation,
 - (iii) demolition work on a structure with structural components that are pre-tensioned or post-tensioned,
 - (iv) demolition work involving a tower crane,
 - (v) demolition work involving a mobile crane with a rated capacity of over 100 tonnes,
 - (vi) demolition work involving floor propping,
 - (vii) demolition work involving explosives.
