Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Amendment (Display of Taxi Fare Hotline Information) Regulation 2023

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following regulation under the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016*.

Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017* to require taxis to display—

- (a) contact information for the Taxi Fare Hotline, and
- (b) a statement that the taxi meter must be on during a rank or hail trip.

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1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Amendment (Display of Taxi Fare Hotline Information) Regulation 2023*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2023.

3 Amendment of Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017

Clause 15 Display of information—taxis

Insert after clause 15(1)—

- (1A) The following information, in the form approved by the Commissioner, must be displayed both in and on a taxi in a way that makes the information clearly visible to passengers in the taxi and to prospective passengers—
- (a) the Taxi Fare Hotline telephone number,
 - (b) a QR code link to the Taxi Fare Hotline telephone number,
 - (c) a statement that the meter must always be on during a rank or hail trip.
