Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to declare employees who would be subject to a limitation on wage increases if the *Industrial Relations (Public Sector Conditions of Employment) Regulation 2014* had not been repealed to be relevant employees to whom certain public sector employers must pay additional contributions under the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*, section 16A.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Amendment Regulation 2023*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2023.

Clause 22A

Insert after clause 22—

22A Relevant employees

For the Act, section 16A(4), definition of *relevant employee*, paragraph (b), an employee who would be subject to a limitation on wage increases under the *Industrial Relations Act 1996*, section 146C if the *Industrial Relations (Public Sector Conditions of Employment) Regulation 2014* had not been repealed is declared to be a relevant employee.
