Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Border Fence Maintenance Regulation 2018* to prescribe the maximum amount that may be imposed and collected by the Border Fence Maintenance Board under the *Border Fence Maintenance Act 1921* as 7 cents per hectare.
