1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administrative Changes—Minister for Finance) Order 2023*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 23 February 2023.

3 Definitions

In this Order—

document means an Act or a statutory or other instrument, or a contract or agreement.

reference to a Minister, Public Service agency or Public Service employee includes a reference that, by or under an Act, is to be read, construed or treated as a reference to that Minister, agency or employee.

Note— The *Constitution Act 1902*, Part 7 and the *Interpretation Act 1987* also contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Order.

4 Construction of certain references to Minister for Finance

A reference in a document to the Minister for Finance is to be read—

- (a) if used in or in relation to the following Acts or provisions—as a reference to the Treasurer—
 - (i) the *Coal and Oil Shale Mine Workers (Superannuation) Act 1941*,
 - (ii) the *Motor Accidents (Lifetime Care and Support) Act 2006*,
 - (iii) the *Sporting Injuries Insurance Act 1978*,
 - (iv) the *State Insurance and Care Governance Act 2015*, Part 2 and Schedules 1 and 2, and Parts 1 and 4 and Schedule 4, but only in so far as the provisions relate to Insurance and Care NSW,
 - (v) the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*, Part 4 and Part 7, Division 1A,
 - (vi) the *Workers Compensation (Bush Fire, Emergency and Rescue Services) Act 1987*,
 - (vii) the *Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act 1942*, or
- (b) in other cases—as a reference to the Minister for Finance.

5 Repeal of Schedule 1

Schedule 1 is repealed at the end of 24 February 2023.
